4.	 Chairman's report: Feedback from the meeting with Jennifer MacPherson (JM) of HIE, KS and KR: JM is to look at arranging training for the Trust's Directors. The Trust is still being considered for a professional advisor for the Board from a bank, maybe RBS. JM is seeking legal advice for the Trust, with a similar Community Benefit Model with regards to the Fish Farm and Meanish Pier. HIE stressed that all Comms and PR should be led and approved by the Board. 	
5.	 Treasurer's report: The bank balance currently stands at £25,862.12. Payments into the account have been received from HIE and funds from the Allen Lane Foundation and the Peoples Health Trust for IT Projects. Outgoings for LDO Salary and Expenses. KR confirmed that a minimum of £2,000 of unrestricted funds needs to be raised by the Trust each year to cover running costs. The Trust has now complied with the Pensions Regulator and a pension plan has been set up through the government's pension scheme NEST. KR currently working on updating the Trust's insurance 	

	 policy with the Highlands Council to cover Public Liability, Employers Liability and to insure both Borrodale school and house and Meanish Pier. KR to raise invoices for stall hire to North Skye Broadband, JR Art and monies also owed from lobster sales. KR and KS to be signatories for the Trust's RBS bank account along with RP.
